TALK ABOUT IT

WAYS TO WORSHIP

God loves when we spend time talking to Him. Use the prayer guide below and spend **P.A.R.T.** of your day talking with God.

Praise - Let God know how much you appreciate His patience and forgiveness.

Admit - Tell God you are sorry for when and how you are impatient.

Request - Ask God to help you to be patient.

Thank God for the ways He has helped you to be patient.



THINK ABOUT IT

Get your Bible, read about faithfulness, and see if you can discover the answers to these questions. *1 Samuel 12:24, Isaiah 25:1, 1 John 1:9, Romans 12:12, 2 Thessalonians 3:3, Proverbs 3:3-4*

- How does God show faithfulness to us?
- How can we be faithful to God? To our friends? To our family?



SHAKE IT UP

Fill a bottle about half full of water. Then add an inch or 2 of vegetable oil on top of the water. Close the lid tightly. Look at your bottle. Notice how the clear water is at the bottom and yellow oil at the top. Shake things up! Can you make the oil stay at the bottom and the water stay on top?

No! No matter how many times we shook or flipped the bottle, the yellow oil faithfully went back to the top. Remember God is faithful and He wants us to be faithful too!
